General Information and Criteria

Awards range from \$100-\$500 (please include a detailed budget.)

- Proposals must show value, creativity and innovation
- Have a clearly defined evaluation process
- Engage students in meaningful activities

We do not fund proposals that are mainly for supplies, or classroom field trips. Your grant will be reviewed by NEF members, educators and community volunteers.

Timeline:

- Proposals are now being accepted, the deadline is 5PM on February 21st

- Winners will be announced in mid March of 2020.
- Funds will be available by the end of March 2020.
