Inspired by a classroom innovation grant NEF funded to a BMHS teacher, NEF is amplifying her **Shark Tank** idea by offering the same opportunity to groups of students in any of the 19 Norwalk schools.

Applications are due by February 26th.

Here's how it works:

Overview

- Students may work alone or with a group. Must have a staff champion from their school.
- Ideas must enhance their school. Ideas should address one or more of the following: academics, extra-curricular activities, social-emotional well being, physical health/nutrition or safety.
- Proposals which can be sustained after the NEF funding period will be given priority.
- Proposals are due by Feb. 26th
- An NEF committee will review proposals and select finalists to present Shark Tank style to a group of community, education and business leaders in mid March.
- Project budgets should not exceed \$500.
- Funding will be provided by end of March.

Submission Criteria

- Proposals should be submitted via email to: info@norwalkeducation.org by Feb. 26th.
- Proposals must include a budget, itemizing all costs. Links to purchasing sites can be included as back up.
- Proposals must be signed off by an educator/administrator in the school who is championing the idea.
- Please answer all questions on the application, not to exceed 2 pages (budget can be separate).

Important

NEF will not fund daily supplies like paper, pens, pencils nor do we fund field trips.
